

Frozen, Jr.
Character Descriptions/Audition Grade Levels

The following list describes all characters included in “Frozen, Jr.” This list also includes the suggested grade level that is appropriate to audition for each specific role.

Young Anna – Female, Grades 2-4 - Princess of Arendelle; a spirited troublemaker who is lonely and longing for connection, especially with her sister

Middle Anna – Female, Grades 5-7 - Princess of Arendelle; a spirited troublemaker who is lonely and longing for connection, especially with her sister

Anna – Female, Grades 8-12 – Princess of Arendelle; a spirited troublemaker who is lonely and longing for connection, especially with her sister

Young Elsa – Female, Grades 2-4 – Princess with magical powers, doting sister to Anna

Middle Elsa – Female, Grades 5-7 – Princess with magical powers, doting sister to Anna

Elsa – Female, Grades 8-12 – Princess, and later, Queen of Arendelle with magical powers; initially a doting sister to Anna, but becomes isolated due to her fear of her magical powers

King Agnarr – Grades 6-12 – King of Arendelle and protective father to Anna and Elsa

Queen Iduna – Grades 6-12 – Queen of Arendelle and descendant of the Northern Nomads; loving mother to Anna and Elsa

Pabbie – Grades 6-12 – Mystical and magical leader of the Hidden Folk; one of Kristoff’s adoptive parents

Bulda – Grades 6-12 – Mystical and magical leader of the Hidden Folk; one of Kristoff’s adoptive parents

Bishop – Grades 4-12 – Bishop of Arendelle, tasked with overseeing the succession of the monarchy

Kristoff – Male, Grades 8-12 – An ice harvester with a prickly exterior but a big heart

Sven – Grades 3-8 – Kristoff’s loyal reindeer best friend

Hans – Male, Grades 8-12 – The charming Prince of the Southern Isles who craves a sense of belonging and power and proves that first impressions can be wrong

Weselton – Grades 4-12 – An impolite and judgmental Duke from a neighboring kingdom

Olaf – Grades 3-8 – A goofy and loving magical snowman who dreams of experiencing summer

Oaken – Grades 4-12 – An amiable wandering salesperson an advocate of hygge

Snow Dancers – Grades 3-12 – Must be strong singers and dancers

Snowflakes – Grades K-2 – Snowflake dancers

Hidden Folk – Grades 3-12

Summer Chorus – Grades K-12

Oaken’s Family – Grades 3-12
